

CMT Achieves Top National Rankings Among Consulting

Commitment to client satisfaction results in award-winning revenue growth.

Two prominent publications covering the engineering consulting industry recently recognized Crawford, Murphy & Tilly, Inc. (CMT) in their rankings of top firms in the nation. CMT was named one of the “Hot Firms” by the *Zweig Letter* and one of the “Top 25 Aviation Firms” by *Engineering News-Record*.

The “Hot Firms” list ranks the top 100 fastest-growing engineering, architecture, and environmental consulting firms in the U.S. CMT earned their place on the list based on revenues that increased 45 percent between 2000 and 2003. The *Zweig Letter* notes that inclusion on the 2004 list is particularly laudable because the growth in revenue occurred during a time of economic instability in the country. CMT also continued to strengthen their position as a national leader in the aviation industry in 2003.
