

CMT Consolidates Indianapolis Operations

Engineering firm furthers its commitment to serve clients in Indiana.

Indianapolis, Ind (January 10, 2005) - Crawford, Murphy & Tilly, Inc. (CMT) has moved its Indianapolis operations to a new location at 5652 West 73rd Street. The Springfield, IL-based consulting engineering firm had been operating out of two separate offices in Indianapolis prior to the January 3, 2005 move.

Demand in the Indianapolis area for CMT's water and wastewater services prompted the firm to establish a permanent presence there in 2003.
