

CMT Rises in Industry Rankings

ENR lists CMT #245 of Top 500 Design Firms; #19 of Top 25 Aviation Firms

CMT rose 12 spots to number 245 on the 2005 *Engineering News Record's* (ENR) list of Top 500 design firms. The firm also rose two spots to land at the number 20 position on ENR's list of Top 25 aviation firms.

Brian Whiston, president and CEO of CMT, credits the performance of his staff for the firm's continued rise in industry rankings. "We have an exceptional staff of dedicated professionals. Their focus on project excellence and client satisfaction is the reason for the firm's growth and success," Whiston said.

The Top 500 list is based on overall revenues for design services performed in 2004. This year's ranking marks the 20th consecutive year that CMT has made the prestigious list of leading engineering and architectural firms. Over the past four years, CMT has gained over 100 spots on the ENR ranking based on revenues that increased over 70 percent during that period.

CMT has been named a Top 25 aviation firm for five of the last six years. The ranking is based on revenues earned on airport projects in 2004. CMT has achieved its high status in the aviation industry through its work at commercial, military, and general aviation facilities.
